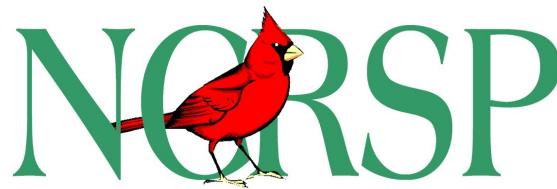


NCRSP lobbyists monitor legislative action

Our lobbyists represent our members at the General Assembly to:

- Obtain annual cost of living adjustments (COLA)
- Maintain reasonable employer contributions to the retirement investment fund
- Maintain no retiree premiums for health insurance and unlimited maximum benefit
- Keep the defined benefit retirement plan for retirees
- Coordinate with other state retiree organizations in order to maximize the impact of our lobbying efforts

NCRSP members participate in press conferences, visit their legislators, research issues, plus send letters, postcards and emails to influence decisions being made in Raleigh impacting retired educators.
